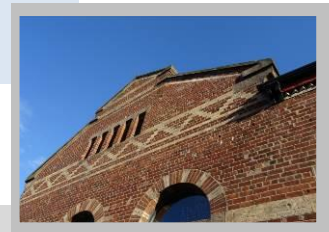

The Crabtree Memorial Bursary

How it all began.....

Leeds Civic Trust was formed in 1965; at the time of its formation it received a generous endowment from Charles Crabtree and his family. To commemorate this, Leeds Civic Trust established the Crabtree Memorial Bursary. Following our 50th birthday celebrations of 2015, it has been decided to offer the bursary as part of our Awards and Grants programme.

The purpose of the Bursary.....

The purpose of the Bursary is twofold:-

- 1) To facilitate studies that encourage deeper understanding and wider appreciation of aspects of the city of Leeds and,
- 2) To use that deeper understanding and appreciation to further the aims and objectives of the Trust.

The objectives of Leeds Civic Trust are to:-

- Encourage high standards of design, architecture and town planning
- Stimulate interest in and care for the history and character of the city
- Encourage the improvement of features of public amenity
- Promote co-operation in the achievement of these objectives

The Bursary itself.....

The award of the Bursary in the sum of **£1000** is made by the Trust on the satisfactory completion of a study/research project relating to the city and in accordance with the objectives listed above. The Bursary is intended to assist with the costs of undertaking the study/research project.

Who can apply.....

The Bursary is available to anyone aged 18 or over living, working or studying in Leeds at the time of application.

Are you interested? This is what you should do.....

You should:-

- visit the Trust's website and download the submission form
- complete the submission form by outlining in **NO** more than 500 words the nature and scope of the proposed study and what form the final submission will take (see below for details)
- complete the form headed 'Background Details'
- send both forms to office@leedscivictrust.org.uk or post to 17-19 Wharf Street, Leeds LS2 7EQ by **31 August**

Some important information to note about submission.....

- All submissions received will be acknowledged
- The Trust will take care of all materials submitted but will not be liable for any loss or damage
- Employees of Leeds Civic Trust or members of the Trust's Council are not eligible to apply
- The Trust is NOT responsible for any expenses incurred in the making of the submission

The selection process.....

The submissions will be considered by a panel of Trust members (the Supervisory Panel) and those short-listed will be invited for interview at the Trust's offices. The final decision will be notified to applicants by **30 September**.

The successful applicant will be expected to undertake their study/research project in the period from **30 September** and submit their completed project to the Trust **NO LATER THAN 1 August**. During the period of study, progress will be monitored by the Supervisory Panel.

The Bursary will be awarded on successful completion of the study/research project.

Please note that Leeds Civic Trust is NOT responsible for expenses incurred by the holder of the Crabtree Bursary.

When the study/research project is completed it should be.....

Presented in one of the following forms:-

- A typewritten document, in hardcopy and digital form, presenting the results, conclusions or recommendations arising from the study, or
- A visual display presenting the results, conclusions or recommendations arising from the study, or
- A combination of the above

What happens then?.....

The Bursary is intended to produce material suitable for use by the Trust in furtherance of its objectives therefore:

- All material submitted as part of the completed study will become the property of the Trust
- The copyright in all material submitted as part of the completed study will become the property of the Trust
- The publication or further use of the material will be at the Trust's discretion
- The final decision rests with Leeds Civic Trust in all matters relating to the Crabtree Memorial Bursary
