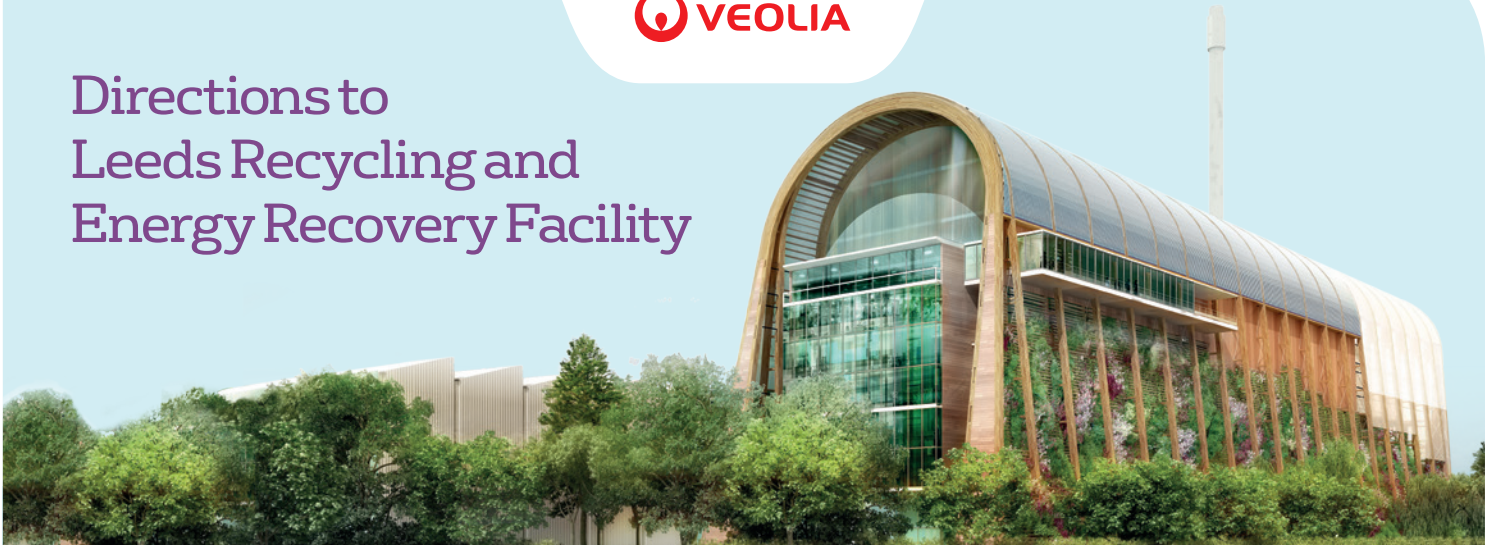


# Directions to Leeds Recycling and Energy Recovery Facility



## Car A1 - M1

Exit at junction 45 and follow the A63 (Pontefract Lane) towards Leeds. Go straight on at the next three roundabouts. Just before the second set of traffic lights, filter into the right-hand lane signposted Halton and Osmondthorpe, then filter back towards Pontefract Lane. Turn left onto Newmarket Approach. The Veolia Recycling and Energy Recovery Facility (RERF) is 50 yards on the right. Once entering the site, turn right into the filter lane in front of weighbridge (small glass-fronted building). The visitor car park can be seen on the right.

## Train

The nearest train station is Leeds City Centre, this is approximately three miles from the Leeds RERF.

## Parking

Limited parking is available and coaches can drop off outside the building in the designated coach bay. Follow signs for visitor car park. There is also a pedestrian walkway and cycle-path route.

## Cycling

Cycle racks available on site, located adjacent to the reception.

## Bus

For bus timetable information to the facility please visit [wypte.acislive.com](http://wypte.acislive.com). The nearest bus stop to the RERF is on Pontefract Lane and is a five minute walk from the site entrance.
